Re: Confirmed case of COVID-19 at Coolmine Community School

A confirmed case of COVID-19 in Coolmine Community School has been notified to the Department of Public Health

A public health risk assessment has been undertaken and at present there is no indication to screen staff or students. The Department of Public Health will continue to liaise with the school.

For parents

If your child develops any symptoms suggestive of Covid-19 infection (such as a **cough, a fever, loss or change in sense of taste or smell**), **please do not send your child to school**, contact your GP and begin restricting your child's movements, as per public health advice.

For staff

If you develop any symptoms suggestive of Covid-19 infection (such as a **cough, a fever, loss or change in sense of taste or smell**), **please do not attend school**, contact your GP and restrict your movements

Restricted movement means avoiding contact with other people and social situations as much as possible. It is also sometimes called 'self-quarantine'.
